- Clear, concise "remove and install" instructions with torque values for each model on facing pages. Based on vehicle makers' information
- Engine damage may occur when a timing belt fails. Engines are identified as either "interference" or "freewheeling".
- Clear line drawings show belt routing for timing and balance shaft belts, belt tensioning method, engine positioning and locking methods, cam and crank timing marks.
- Vehicle makers' recommended belt replacement intervals (if applicable) for each model - helps auto repair shops encourage vehicle owners to have timing belts replaced regularly.
- Special tools are identified where required
- Labor times for removal and installation
